

# bSI Awards 2016- Submission Format

## *Developing material for submission*

To participate in the competition, several types of materials should be prepared and submitted to buildingSMART International. The abstract should form the key part of your application as, through it, you have the opportunity to showcase the breadth and depth of your project. Please ensure that your submission includes:

1. A detailed and concise abstract in 250-1,000 words that defines the project goal and how it was achieved. Explain how obstacles and challenges were overcome.
2. Basic project information (name and location of the project, type of project, cost of project, organisations involved, stage of project)
3. Statements from project participants and third parties, if possible, about the benefits of using buildingSMART solutions
4. Concrete samples of experience gained in the projects, relating to the use of buildingSMART solutions
5. A maximum of three images (300 dpi or higher resolution) in TIFF, JPEG or EPS formats
6. Samples, e.g. models, from the projects. The material will be handled discreetly by the judging panel. However, it will be appreciated if the material can be donated to the buildingSMART community and shared worldwide to demonstrate the use of open standards.

Items 1-4 must be limited to three text pages. Appendixes can be used to present additional information. Please be aware that items 1-5 may be published on the buildingSMART International website.
